


Nurturing Advanced All-round Achievers

Who are Advanced All-round Achievers?

Academic outcome of 3 x 3 education

Students who have been empowered with skills & knowledge in 3 categories (strengths) and learned from various experiences in 3 aspects (faces).

Recognition as an Advanced All-round Achiever (AAA)



Verifying the differences between Advanced All-round Achievers and other students (conducted by Benesse i-Career, October 2023)

- Multifaceted tests that measure the problem-solving skills needed to tackle open-ended challenges for success in society
- 260 AAA and 353 other students in their fourth year of undergraduate studies

Advanced All-round Achievers' scores were significantly higher than other students
(study in 2019 shows a similar trend)

Nurtured future leaders capable of thriving in a global society

Foundation Course for Post Graduate Studies

Provided an academic Japanese program for prospective students and enabled them to have a smooth start at graduate schools.

L-café: Social Learning Space

Created an environment on campus where students can learn about cross-cultural values and relations.

Educational Reform for Learner-centered Study

Implemented a four-term system with 50-minute classes, securing opportunities for study abroad and long-term internships

University-wide Global Experiential Education

Promoted campus-wide international internships and exchange programs with overseas partner universities

International Baccalaureate (IB) Admission for All Faculties

Implemented IB admission to recruit students with a global-mindset and practical inquiry skills

Discovery Program for Global Learners

Developed an undergraduate course that integrates the humanities, arts, and sciences with English as the medium of instruction

Graduate School of Interdisciplinary Science and Engineering in Health Systems

Integrated an academic approach through medical-engineering collaboration and integrating the arts and sciences

Memorandum of understanding

January 2020: Exchanged a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with UNCTAD (United Nations Conference on Trade and Development)

January 2024: MoU Renewal

April 2024: An official side event was organized at the CSTD's annual meeting. Young Female Scientists who had participated in our human resource development programs took to the podium and shared their experiences including the significance of taking part in the programs, with the attendees from around the world.





