Transcripts will be issued twice a year for first-year students in March and September. From the second year onwards, it will be issued once a year in March.

For parents/guardians residing outside of Japan, please note that the transcript will be issued directly to the student (your child) at the counter. We kindly ask that you obtain the transcript from the student.

For your reference, we have listed the graduation requirements and the minimum number of credits students are expected to earn by the end of each academic year. Please note that these minimum credit targets are not required for academic progression but are considered as one of the criteria when applying for some scholarships. However, students must earn the minimum required number of credits by the end of the third year to begin a senior project for graduation.

- Graduation Requirements: 124 credits
- Minimum number of credits to be earned
 - By the end of the 1st year: 25 credits
 - By the end of the 2nd year: 55 credits
 - By the end of the 3rd year: 92 credits
- The maximum number of credits students can register for is 50 per year (hereinafter referred to as the “credit cap”).
However, a student whose cumulative GPA is 3.00 or above at the end of the academic year may be permitted to register for courses beyond the aforementioned credit cap in the subsequent school year.

[Note] Courses/subjects marked with an asterisk “★” in the “Grade” row on the transcript are mainly offered as intensive courses during the summer break, and the grades will be released in mid-October.
