## The 1st Okayama University and King Faisal University's Workshop on Environmental and Life Science

Okayama University and Saudi Arabia's King Faisal University held their first joint workshop on "Workshop on Environmental and Life Science" under the auspices of the Royal Embassy of Saudi Arabia at the International House on November 13th.
