

Information about the Student ID Card

To students who hold a student ID card valid until March 2018



Valid until March 2018

- ① For students who are expected to graduate from the University, go on to pursue a postgraduate degree or complete their postgraduate degree
Please check the notice “学生証のお知らせ「卒業・修了される学生のみなさんへ」”(Information about Notice: Student ID Cards: To students who will graduate, or complete faculty studies or graduate school)” on the bulletin board.
- ② For students who will remain in the same faculty/school, graduate school, or academic entity in and after April 2018
You do not need to submit an application for a new student ID card. As soon as your new card is available, you will receive it in exchange for your existing card.
If you are a Co-op member, you will be able to use your existing card at Co-op shops until you exchange it for a new one.

Start of exchange: Around mid-April

Location: Travel Service Center, Peach Union (1F)

* The start date for exchange will be posted on the bulletin board of your faculty, school, graduate school or other academic entity, as soon as it is fixed.

Issuance of a temporary student ID card (for applicants only)

If you apply, you will be issued a temporary student ID card that you can use until you receive a new student ID card. You can use this temporary card as proof of your identification during April 2018.
