
## Information about the Student ID Card



## To students who hold a student ID card valid until September 2019



Tor students who are expected to graduate from the University, go on to pursue a postgraduate degree or complete their postgraduate degree

Please check the notice "学生証のお知らせ「2019年6月,9月,12月に卒業・修了される学生のみなさんへ」 (Information about Notice: Student ID Cards: To students who will graduate, or complete faculty studies or graduate school)" on the bulletin board.

② For students who will remain in the same faculty/school, graduate school, or academic entity in and after October 2019

You do not need to submit an application for a new student ID card. As soon as your new card comes available, you will receive it in exchange for your existing card.

If you are a Co-op member, you will be able to use your existing card at Co-op shops until you exchange it for a new one.

What to bring: Student ID card, temporary student ID card (for student who have it only)

## Issuance of a temporary student ID card (for applicants only)

<u>If you apply.</u> you will be issued a temporary student ID card that you can use until you receive a new student ID card. You can use this temporary card as proof of your identification during October 2019.

Issued by: Academic affairs staff (Kyomu Tanto) of your own faculty/school What to bring: Photo for your temporary student ID card (3.0 cm long x 2.4 cm wide, in full color or black and white)

\* It takes about 10 minutes to issue a temporary student ID card.
