- ② For students who will remain in the same faculty/school, graduate school, or academic entity in and after April 2020

You do not need to submit an application for a new student ID card. As soon as your new card is available, you will receive it in exchange for your existing card.

If you are a Co-op member, you will be able to use your existing card at Co-op shops until you exchange it for a new one.
