## To students who hold a student ID card valid until March 2024



① For students who are expected to graduate from the University, go on to pursue a postgraduate degree or complete their postgraduate degree

Please check the notice "卒業・修了される学生のみなさんへ「学生証のお知らせ」(To students who will graduate, or complete faculty studies or graduate school: Information about Notice: Student ID Cards)" on the bulletin board.

② For students who will remain in the same faculty/school, graduate school, or academic entity in and after April 2024

You do not need to submit an application for a new student ID card. As soon as your new card comes available, you will receive it <u>in exchange for your existing card</u>.

If you are a Co-op member, you will be able to use your existing card at Co-op shops until you exchange it for a new one.

- What to bring: Student ID card, temporary student ID card (for student who have it only) you have.

## Issuance of a temporary student ID card (for applicants only)

<u>If you apply</u>, you will be issued a temporary student ID card that you can use until you receive a new student ID card. You can use this temporary card as proof of your identification during April 2024.
