


# Notice Regarding Student ID Cards

## To students who hold a student ID card valid until March 2026



Valid until March 2026  
(2026 年 3 月まで有効)

- ① Students scheduled to graduate in March 2026, including those who will continue on to a master's or doctoral program at Okayama University after graduation  
Please check the notice "To students who will graduate: Important Information about Student ID" on the bulletin board.
- ② Students who will continue to be enrolled in the same faculty/school or graduate school from April 2026 onward  
You do not need to apply for a new student ID card. Once your new card is ready for distribution, you will receive it in exchange for your current card.  
If you are a Co-op member, you will be able to use your existing card at Co-op shops until you get a new one.

- Start of exchange: Thursday, April 9<sup>th</sup>, 2026
- What to bring: Your current student ID card  
Temporary student ID card (Only if you have one)
- Location: Alumni Building 1F Kojika Shop

### Issuance of a temporary student ID card (for those who wish)

If you would like, you can apply for a temporary student ID card, which is valid until you receive a new student ID card. It can be used as proof of identity during April 2026.

Issued by: Academic Affairs Office (Kyomu Tanto) at your faculty/school or graduate school

What to bring: Photo for your temporary student ID card  
(3.0 cm long x 2.4 cm wide, in full color or black and white)

\* It may take about 10 minutes to issue a temporary student ID card.
