Courses selected by lottery cannot be removed.

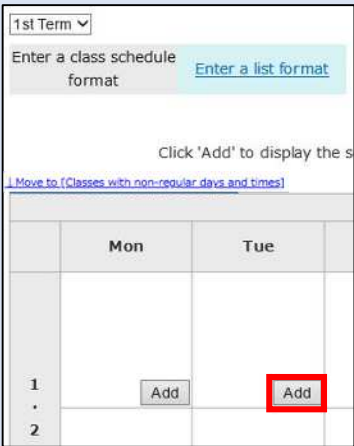
*The courses assigned by post-lottery applications cannot be cancelled after the post-lottery application period ends.
