

Discovery Program for Global Learners

For those international student's parents/guardians residing outside of Japan, please note that the transcript will be handed over to the student at the counter, and we would like to kindly ask you to receive it from the student. Transcript will be issued twice a year, in March and September for first-year students.

However, from second year onwards, it will be issued only once a year, in March.

For your reference, we have listed the graduation requirement as well as the minimum number of credits expected to be earned by the end of each academic year. Please note that the minimum number of credits to be earned is not required for progression but is considered as one of the criteria when applying for some scholarships. In addition, the minimum number of credits to be earned at the end of the third year is required to start a senior project for graduation.

- Graduation Requirement: 124 credits
- Minimum number of credits to be earned
 - By the end of 1st year: 25 credits
 - By the end of 2nd year: 55 credits
 - By the end of 3rd year: 92 credits
- The number of credits for which Program students can register shall not exceed 50 credits per year (hereinafter referred to as "credit cap").
However, a student whose cumulative GPA is 3.00 or above at the end of a school year may be permitted to register for courses beyond the aforementioned credit cap in the subsequent school year.

[Note] Courses/subjects marked with an asterisk "★" in the "Grade" row on the transcript are mainly offered as intensive courses during the Spring break, and the grades have not yet been finalized by the end of February.
