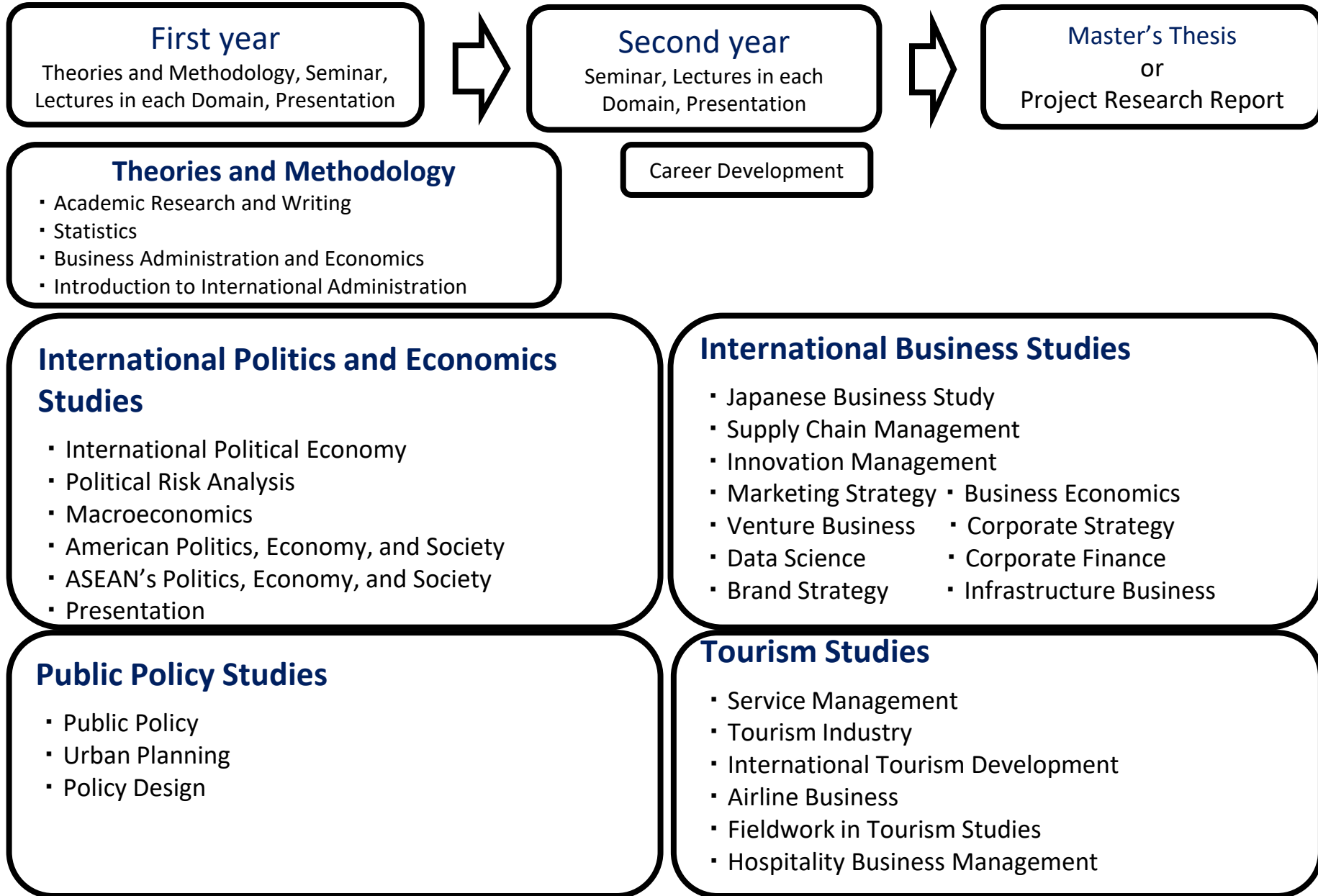

Your Next Step: Admission Guideline

Educational Requirements (either a or b):

- a) The completion of at least **16 years** of education including a bachelor's degree.
- b) If an applicant has less than **16 years** of education with one of the following conditions, he/she may be qualified to apply:
 - The completion of at least three years of tertiary-level education including a bachelor's degree. The JIU Admissions Assessment Committee will assess an applicant's eligibility upon his/her request.
 - 22 years-old or older with sufficient work experience as a researcher, an instructor at an academic institution or a specialist in the fields relevant to this Master's Program. The JIU Admissions Assessment Committee will assess an applicant's eligibility upon his/her request.

English Language Proficiency Minimum Requirements (either one of the following):

FAQs: Admission

- **My undergraduate degree is not related to the core domains offered by GSIA. Can I still apply for GSIA?**
→Yes. In selection, we take into accounts all the experiences you have; especially, how your research interest is aligned with your undergraduate study and/or career.
- **I don't have any work experiences. Am I still qualified as candidate?**
→Yes. The completion of at least 16 years of education including a bachelor's degree is the minimum educational requirements.
If you only have the completion of at least three years of tertiary-level education including a bachelor's degree, the JIU Admissions Assessment Committee will assess an applicant's eligibility upon his/her request.

FAQs: Living in Japan

- **What is the average cost of living in Japan?**
→ It is estimated to be 90,000 to 120,000JPY (approx. \$650 - \$850 USD), including all the costs such as house-renting fee, foods, travel fees, textbook fees, etc.
- **Can I take Japanese language courses before enrolling GSIA?**
→ Yes. There is a Japanese language course for international students for 2 years at Togane campus. The first year will focus on the language and the second year will learn about Japanese culture. After you enroll in GSIA, however, you can not take these language courses because the campus is different.

FAQs: Career Support

- **Do you offer any career support for graduate students?**
 - Yes we do. First, GSIA offers “Career Development” class for its students to be better prepared for finding jobs not only in Japan, but also in their home countries.
 - A variety of career supports are also available through our International Office and Career Development Office.
